Primary Election – Tuesday, August 24, 2010
General Election – Tuesday, November 2, 2010

After Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository has been filed - First day to begin collecting petitions, a DS/DE 9 must be on file. (Florida Statute 99.095 (2)(a))

May 17th, **NOON** – Last date to submit petitions to local Supervisor of Elections for verification, “28th day preceding the first day of the qualifying period for the office sought . . .” (Florida Statute 99.095 (3))

June 7th – Petitions must be certified by this date, “7th day before the first day of the qualifying period for the office sought . . .” (Florida Statute 99.095 (3))

June 14th, **NOON** through June 18th, **NOON** - Candidate Qualifies with Supervisor of Elections office. Copy of Petition Certification along with all other qualifying documents to be filed. (No qualifying fee is required).

As of Book Closing for the November 2008 General Election -

Countywide total registered voters 604,083 x 1% = **6,041** signatures required.

School Board, District 1 total registered voters 85,283 x 1% = **853** signatures required.

School Board, District 2 total registered voters 106,886 x 1% = **1069** signatures required.

School Board, District 3 total registered voters 83,142 x 1% = **831** signatures required.

County Commission District 2 total registered voters 90,015 x 1% = **900** signatures required.

County Commission District 4 total registered voters 133,501 x 1% = **1335** signatures required.

County Commission District 6 total registered voters 73,389 x 1% = **734** signatures required.

April 26th, **NOON** through April 30th, **NOON** - Candidate Qualifies with Supervisor of Elections office. Copy of Petition Certification along with all other qualifying documents to be filed. (No qualifying fee is required).
