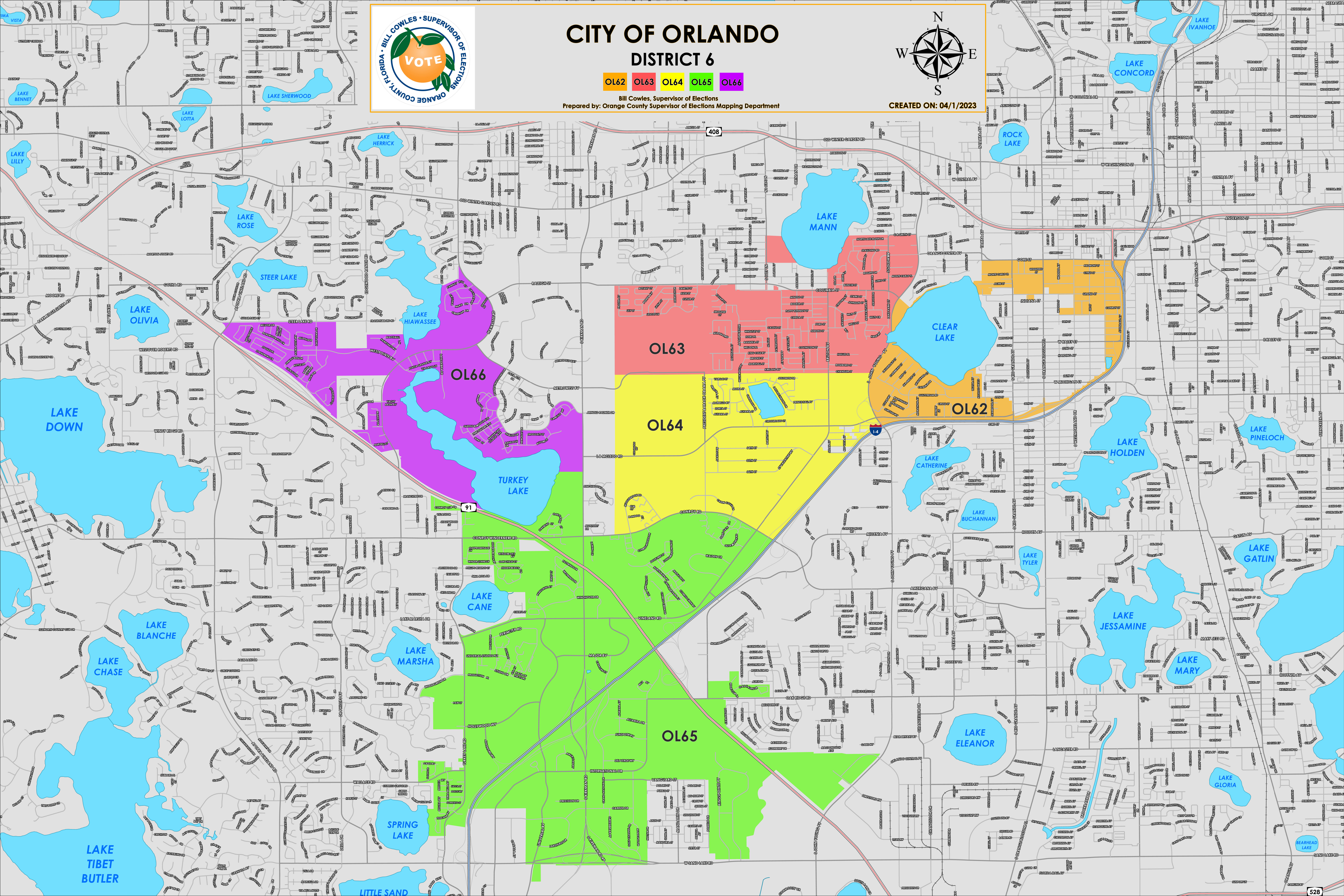

The City of Orlando District 6 in Orange County, Florida contains municipal precincts OL62, OL63, OL64, OL65, and OL66.

District 6 northern boundary runs along Gore St, C R Smith St, Raleigh St, Lake Hiawassee and Steer Lake Rd. Sand Lake Road is the southern boundary. Western boundary begins just west of Turkey Lake Rd and extends NW along Florida Turnpike up to Apopka Vineland Rd. Eastern boundary runs along John Young Parkway and Interstate 4. Within these borders are many sections which are considered unincorporated Orange County, and not part of the City of Orlando.
