

The City of Orlando District 4 in Orange County, Florida contains municipal precinct OL53.

Municipal precinct OL53 approximately extends north along I-4 to Michigan Street, ends in the south at Oak Ridge Road, Calendula Dr, Queen Anne Dr, Conroy Rd and Americana Blvd. The western boundary is I-4 and Florida Turnpike (91). The eastern boundary extends to Texas Boulevard. Within these borders are many sections which are considered unincorporated Orange County, and not part of the City of Orlando. This municipal precinct also includes the following Orange County precincts:

Each listed Orange County precinct is partially made up of the City of Orlando and partially unincorporated Orange County, which change according to municipal annexation ordinances.
